Know Before You Go Guide



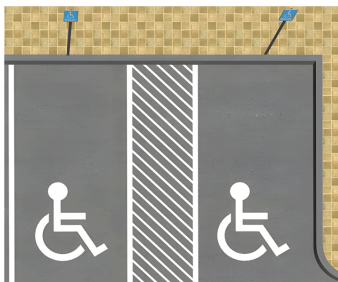
Erne Water Taxi is located in Enniskillen, Co Fermanagh. We have two types of boats to explore Lough Erne. This guide will help you get ready for your visit.

The Island Discovery boat leaves from the Enniskillen Castle Jetty. The nearest car park is at Enniskillen Castle. It has Blue Badge spaces and is 30 metres from the boat. There is level access on to the boat with wide access points.



The Island Discovery boat is good for wheelchairs. It has a flat deck, so moving around is easy. Seating is flexible. Our boats hold 12 people standing or 6 wheelchair users on board at once.



Assistance dogs are welcome on the boat and water is available for them. The open deck gives them space to be comfortable during the trip.



Our Erne Water Taxi is a smaller, quicker boat that can fit up to 8 people. This boat is not accessible for wheelchair users.



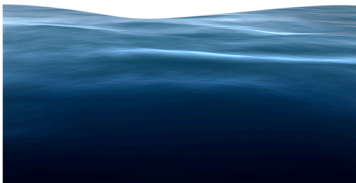
There are no toilets on either boat. We recommend you use the toilets at Enniskillen Castle before you leave. There is also changing places available in the Castle.



Sensory Tools in Nature

You can see the calming waters of Lough Erne from the boat. The Island Discovery boat runs on a quiet electric motor. Enjoy the peace and listen to the sounds of the lough, wind, and wildlife.



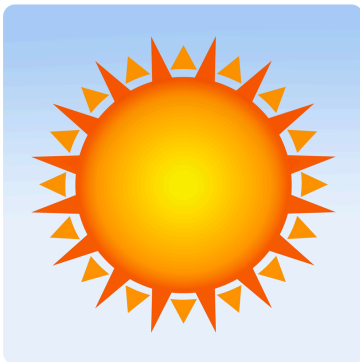
Look at the river banks and clouds in the sky as you travel. Can you spot shapes? It is calming to notice what's around you.
